- 1. Shawn Endsley convened the meeting at 6:33 PM
- 2. Minutes of the November 11, 2020 meeting were read.

- 4. Lent To date there has been no direction issued by the Diocese of Arlington. Direction is expected within the next few weeks.
- 5. On December 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020 President Trump issued a proclamation on the 850<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the martyrdom of St. Thomas A Becket. Link on the Parish Website (Since removed).
- 6. 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of St Thomas A Becket: The Bishop Burbidge's visit is currently scheduled for April 18<sup>th</sup>. This will likely be rescheduled sometime during the summer months.
